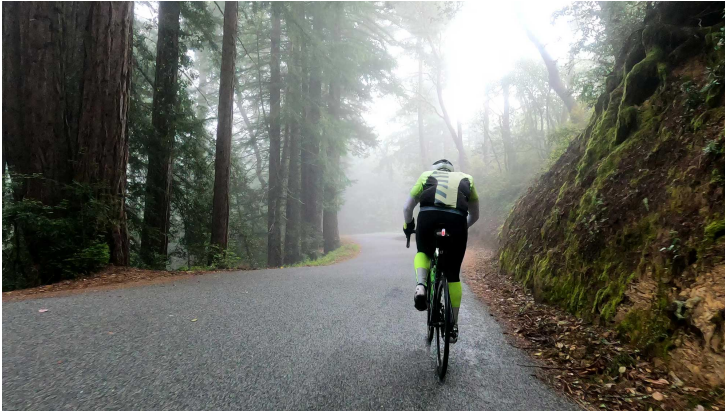


Old news for sure.... still ready for it to get warmer!
